# INTRODUCTION FROM PHIL ORAM REGIONAL DIRECTOR

Climate change has never been higher on the public and corporate agenda, and I am very proud of the leadership we have continued to show in delivering more sustainable workplaces. Our participation in the Business in the Community Circular Office task force has helped deliver a joined up vision and real practical guidance for organisations who are seeking change.

In November 2018, we cemented our commitment to the workplace change sector by announcing the acquisition of Premier Workplace Services, a leading provider in the UK workplace change category. With a 20+ year track record, they are seen as leaders of sustainability within the workplace industry, bringing an unrivaled sustainable approach to the sector.

Since the acquisition we have been able to extend our service offering over a wider geographical area and deliver further logistic and resource efficiencies: sharing fleet, reducing unnecessary road miles and optimising workflows, and reducing our environmental impact.

The Renew Centre continues to remain the UK's first leading independent commercial facility dedicated to remanufacturing office furniture, becoming a beacon for visitors who want to see the 'circular economy' in action. It has attracted global visitors from press, academia and industry pioneers. In Autumn 2018, visitors from the IKEA HQ came to learn more about the 'how and what' we are doing in terms of office furniture repair, refurbishment and remanufacturing. Due to the success of the visit, a reciprocal trip was organised to share our story to the wider IKEA team.

As we look to develop longer term integration plans, sustainability will remain at the core of our growing and developing service offering; continuing to support our clients with their sustainability agenda. I look forward to further updating on the exciting achievements we plan to make in this area.

We have invested in Cabinet Vision software, which reduces waste by eliminating the need for prototypes. In 2018/19, 28 bespoke items were designed using Cabinet Vision, saving 1.36 tonnes of chipboard.




## **ENABLING IT REUSE**

Our IT Services provide a secure, sustainable and compliant clearance for redundant IT and electrical equipment. Throughout 2018/19, there has been some extensive reorganisation of the Renew IT secure facility to support the service expansion; and help work towards Asset Disposal and Information Security Disposal (ADISA) accreditation for our operations. This has included the expansion of the secure storage area, and the development of an additional area for secure date eradication.


# 2. REDUCING OUR ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

We have been measuring our own carbon footprint for at least seven years, in order to understand and enable us to reduce our emissions. The biggest contributor to our carbon footprint is our transport fleet, which comprised around 85% of our scope 1 and 2 emissions at 605 tonnes CO2(e). Electricity accounts for 102 tonnes CO2(e) total emissions, 708 tonnes for 2018/19.

The focus of our operations is to facilitate waste prevention and reuse, prioritising how we manage waste generated at our own sites; as well as storage clearances for our clients.



Over 199 tonnes of waste was diverted from landfill to an energy from waste facility



We recovered 90% of energy from residual waste



Reducing electricity usage Lighting at the Ardra Road sites have been replaced with LED, saving an estimated 34 tonnes of CO2 a year.



### Improving fleet efficiency

We have had a rolling vehicle replacement programme in place to ensure all fleet vehicles above 3.5 tonnes are fully ULEZ compliant. In the past two years, we have replaced a total of 18 older vehicles with new vehicles.

We are FORS Bronze accredited at both of our operating centres.




# Transitioning to the updated ISO 14001 standard

Through our expanding sustainability network, we continue to provide thought leadership and insights on the most important trends in sustainability; helping to advise organisations on how they can change their environmental impact.




### BITC circular office guide




